

THINK AHEAD!

THERE'S A HUGE PRICE TO PAY FOR INACTION ON POPULATION GROWTH.

In the swirl of current events the population crisis is getting swept aside, but it is really at the heart of so many of our current and future problems. How can our already greatly overpopulated nation possibly hope to address successfully the critical issues of food, energy, health care, infrastructure, water resources and global warming if we allow our population to continue growing?

Driven by mass immigration, our U.S. population is projected to grow from 307 million at present to 450 million by 2050 – just 41 years from now. For the sake of present and future generations we cannot allow that to happen.

To halt, and eventually reverse, our population growth as soon as possible, we urgently need to stop any further illegal immigration and drastically reduce the estimated 15 to 20 million illegal immigrants now living here permanently. We also need to cap legal immigration at no more than 200,000 a year.

The most urgent task facing our nation is to decide at what size to stabilize our population. The best way to do this would be for Congress to create a U.S. Commission on Population Growth charged with addressing that question. Once a goal was established, the next step would be to recommend programs to reach that goal. The result would be something we urgently need: A National Population Policy.
