The ad should be text only, original and entirely the student's work. Key issues to be addressed are population size and growth, the birth rate, immigration (legal and illegal), amnesty programs, environmental destruction, natural resource depletion, birthright citizenship, overcrowded cities and schools, or other issues related to the efforts of Negative Population Growth. www.npg.org

Do not include pictures. You may suggest a picture you think would complement your ad, however the ad will be judged on text only. At the completion of the contest, the ads may be published.
